## Personal Development – 'Call it out' Performance by Loudmouth

This week Years 9 & 10 watched a play about harmful sexual behaviours and sexual assault. It dealt with the repeated experiences of catcalling, sexual languages and jokes as well as physical assaults. It also challenged the concept of 'banter' and exploring the role that boys and young men can have in challenging and shifting attitudes and behaviour amongst their peers. This includes empowering young men to be part of the change in culture around harmful sexual behaviour. It questioned the role of porn and other online content in skewing attitudes about consent and the impact on real relationships. The performance ended with the realisation of how and why we should all call out negative sexual behaviour and where to report or share incidents and get help and support.
