PRIVACY NOTICE

Managing Your Child's Personal Information

At Sir William Romney School, we collect and use personal information about your child to provide a safe, supportive, and effective education. This includes information needed for day-to-day school management, safeguarding, monitoring progress, and participating in certain activities or programs. We take your child's privacy seriously and aim to be clear about what information we hold and how we use it.

Your Consent and Rights

You have the right to change or withdraw any consent you have previously given for the collection, use, or sharing of your child's personal information at any time, in line with this privacy notice. For children under 13, parents or guardians make these decisions. For children aged 13–15, we may consider both the parent's and child's views, and children aged 16 and above can make decisions about their own personal data, including sharing limited information with local authorities or youth support services. To update or withdraw consent, please contact admin@theathelstantrust.org. Once we receive your request, we will stop processing your child's information for the purposes you originally agreed to, unless there is another lawful reason to continue.
